

ASC Communities Receive 2018 Silver - Commitment to Quality Award

The Silver Award is the second of three distinctions possible through the American Health Care Association and National Center for Assisted Living (AHCA/NCAL) as part of their [National Quality Award Program](#). The Bronze Award is the third. Communities that have achieved all quality goals receive the Gold Award.

“This year’s award recipients are leading the way for others in the profession in pursuing quality care,” said AHCA/NCAL National Quality Award Board of Overseers Chair Alana Wolfe. “I commend them on this accomplishment and challenge them to continue making progress in quality improvement.”

The communities will be honored during AHCA/NCAL’s 69th Annual Convention and Exposition, October 7-10, 2018 in San Diego, California.
