Recently, the Indiana State Department of Health released new guidance for outdoor family visitation. Only communities that meet specific criteria can allow visitations to occur; residents and families are thrilled that Arbor Grove has been cleared to have outdoor visitations. Visitors are screened, asked to sign-in, wear a face mask and adhere to proper social distancing along with other criteria during the visitation.
